



## TERM OF COMPETITION

### 1. ORGANIZER

CIPUTRA GOLFPRENEUR JUNIOR WORLD 2026 will be managed by championship committee whose decision in all matters relating to the championship shall be final. Herein after called “the Committee”.

### 2. APPROVAL & SANCTION

The tournament is sanctioned by the Asia-Pacific Golf Federation (APGC) and the Indonesia Golf Association (PGI).

### 3. HOST VENUE/ARCHITECT

Damai Indah Golf, PIK Course

### 4. DATES OF CHAMPIONSHIP

Competition Schedule:

Tuesday, 9 <sup>th</sup> June 2026	Official Practice Round, Opening Ceremony

Thursday, 11 <sup>th</sup> June 2026	Round 2

### 5. YARDAGE/PAR/COURSE/SLOPE RATING (Subject to Change)

#### BOYS:

- Blue Tees. Approx. 6084 meters/6692 yards. Par 72 Course/Slope Rating 72.7/130

#### GIRLS:

- White Tees. Approx. 5497 meters/6047 yards. Par 72 Course/Slope Rating 74.9/138

#### DEVELOPMENT C Class BOYS:

- White Tees. Approx. 5497 meters/6047 yards. Par 72 Course/Slope Rating 74.9/138

#### DEVELOPMENT C Class GIRLS:

- Red Tees. Approx. 4970 meters/5467 yards. Par 72 Course/Slope Rating 72.2/130

### 6. ELIGIBILITY

Players who have amateur status in accordance to by the R&A Rules Limited and the United States Golf Association and are approved by The Committee” with the following criteria:

- Participants’ maximum Handicap Index is 10.0 for boys and 12.0 for Girls, and have not reached his/her 19th birthday by June 11, 2026.
- Other junior players can also compete in the DEVELOPMENT C category class if they have not reached his/her 13th birthday by June 11, 2026 (Only for individual competition) and have minimum age of 10 years old during the start of the competition.

### 7. INVITATIONS



The Committee will selectively invite players of 2 Boys & 2 Girls to represent respective countries as nominated by the Unions/Federations/Associations. The selection process will be at the Committee's sole discretion based on players' WAGR, other track performance and availability. Invited players are to be accorded with three (3) nights' accommodation on twin sharing basis, free breakfast and lunch at the host venue, and exempted from entry fees. A room for 1 coach/team manager for each country will also be provided for three (3) nights' stay. All other expenses are on players' own account.

## 8. CADDIES DURING COMPETITION

- a. There will be no caddies allowed during competition days.
  - Caddies & golf cart are allowed only on the practice round day (at players' own expense).
  - No motorized trolley is allowed.
- b. Caddies will be allowed for DEVELOPMENT CLASS C only during competition days. All caddies must be on course caddy.

## 9. FORMAT

54 holes stroke play competition:

- a. **TEAM EVENT** — A team shall consist of Four: two (2) boy players and two (2) girl players (total 4 players) who must be citizens or permanent residents of that country. The combined best gross scores of three (3) team members for each round will determine the team's score for Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3. The Team who returns the lowest aggregate Gross score (for 3 rounds) over 54 holes or Less (to be decided by The Committee) shall be declared as The Champion.
- b. **INDIVIDUAL** — The competitor who returns the lowest aggregate Gross score over 54 holes or less shall be declared as The Champion Individual.
- c. **CUT-OFF** — Following the first 36 holes, the top (50)% and ties of each group advance to the final round. Players who do not make the cut will transition to the Consolation Round to complete the tournament and eligible to contribute to the respective Team's overall scoring.

## 10. AWARDS

Awards will be as follows:

1. **TEAM WINNERS**
  - (Team Awards consists of 2 Boys & 2 Girls): Top 3 winners
2. **INDIVIDUAL WINNERS**
  - The Overall Champion Boys and Girls Trophies
  - 2 Runner-ups Boys and Girls

The Overall Champion Boys and Girls Trophies and trophies/ commemorative gifts to 2 Runner-ups Boys and Girls.

The winner of the Overall Champion Boys will be granted the right to participate in The Ciputra Golfpreneur ADT Tournament Aug 2026 while winner of the Overall Champion Girls will be granted the right to participate in Indonesia Women's Open Jan 2027.



### 3. OTHER AWARDS

- BEST PROMISING PLAYERS — Commemorative gifts for three Individual Boys and Girls Division with the lowest scores after 3 rounds (for those who have not reached his/her 15th birthday before 11 June 2026)
- BEST PROMISING INDONESIAN PLAYERS — Commemorative gift for each Individual Boys and Girls Division with the lowest scores after 3 rounds (for those who have not reached his/her 15th birthday before 11 June 2026)

### 4. CONSOLATION

- Commemorative gifts for the three best gross individual Boys and Girls in the Consolation Round

Please note that each winner from the respective categories can only receive 1 trophy/ Commemorative gift decided by The Committee

### 5. DEVELOPMENT C CLASS — BOYS/GIRLS WINNERS

- Overall gross individual Boys and Girls winners in the DEVELOPMENT C category class (for those they have not reached his/her 13th birthday by June 11, 2026.) Boys — 1 Winner and 2 Runner-Ups. GIRLS — 1 Winner and 2 Runner-Ups

### 11. TIES

Ties for first place, in both Individual Overall and Team Champion, will be settled by a hole-by-hole play-off. For Team Champion play-off, Team Captain should appoint one of the team members to represent their teams in the hole-by-hole play-off. All minor placings shall be decided by matching scorecard based on a count back system as follows:

#### For Individuals:

- Last 18 holes, if a tie still persists, then,
- Last 9 holes (hole 10-18), if a tie still persists, then,
- Last 6 holes (hole 13-18), if a tie still persists, then,
- Last 3 holes (hole 16-18), if a tie still persists, then,
- Hole 18.

If a tie still persists, then the preceding 18 holes, 9 holes, 6 holes, 3 holes in that order.

#### For Teams:

- Total Team Score (Round 3)
- Total Team Score (Round 2)
- Total Team Score (Round 1)
- Unselected Player (Round 3)

### 12. OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND

All players are entitled to have 1 practice round (excluding golf cart fee and caddy tips) on Tuesday, 9th June 2026 at PIK Course (Morning tee time & last tee off time at 9.30 am) and must be reserved in advance. Practice round before that date will be subject to payment of normal Green Fees. This does not apply to Members of Damai Indah Golf.

### 13. DRIVING RANGE



Players may practice at the driving range upon payment on his/her account (IDR 100,000,- for 50 balls). On the tournament days (10<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026) every player is entitled FREE 50 balls at the driving range.

#### **14. RULES OF GOLF**

The Championship will be played in accordance with the most recent Rules of Golf approved by The R&A Rules Limited and the USGA, IGA Hard Card 2025, Additional Term of Competition, and Local Rules approved by The Committee. Disputes, if any, will be settled by the Committee, and a decision made by The Committee will be final.

#### **15. PACE OF PLAY**

The player shall play in accordance with the Pace of Play Policy laid down by the Committee.

#### **16. COMPETITION CLOSED**

The championship shall be deemed to have closed when the prizes has been awarded to the winners.

#### **17. DECISION**

- a. If a referee has been appointed by the Committee, his/ her decision is final (Rule 20.2).
- b. In absence of referee, any dispute or doubtful point on the rules must be referred to the Committee, whose decisions is final (Rule 20.2).

#### **18. DISPUTES**

Any disputes or doubtful points on the rules shall be referred to the Committee as soon as possible on completion of the round and in any case not later than 15 minutes after finishing the round.

#### **19. INDEMNITY & LIABILITIES**

- a. In signing of entry form, participant in this tournament shall testify and not hold liable to the organizer.
- b. The Committee and their staff will not be responsible for any loss damage or harm, or any form of injuries that participation of the tournament may suffer as result of their participation in this tournament.

#### **20. CONSENT TO POTRAIT RIGHTS**

By applying to participate in this event, the applicant shall be deemed to have agreed to transfer to the organizers the right of portrait of the Athlete in photographs, television, radio, film, and other recordings made by the organizers for the purpose of broadcasting, replaying, reporting, and publicity during this event (including pre- and post-event events associated with the Convention at the convention site), as well as in any other media approved by the organizers.

#### **21. TRANSPORTATION AND GOLF CART**

- a. Unless otherwise permitted by the Committee, players shall not use automotive transportation during a stipulated round.
- b. GOLF CART WILL BE PROVIDED FOR TEAM CAPTAINS ONLY: IDR 300.000/DAY (PERSONAL COST)

#### **22. EVACUATION PLAN**



Rules officials, observers, roving marshals will take players and caddies to shelter on the course until the 4 buses situated on the course will fetch and transported them to the Clubhouse.

Location of buses on the course:

- a. Bus No. 1 (between Clubhouse and tee box 10) For evacuation of players on hole 1, 2, 10, 17, and 18.
- b. Bus No. 2 (on road behind green 14 and shelter hole 15) For evacuation of players on hole 2, 3, 4, 15 and 16.
- c. Bus No. 3 (on road behind tee box 5 and green 14) For evacuation of players on hole 5, 6, 9, 13 and 14.
- d. Bus No. 4 (on road behind green 12 and tee box 13) For evacuation of players on hole 7, 8, 9, 11 and 12.

All players and their caddies will be transported back to their last location on the course, while waiting for the signal for resume play.

### **23. INCLEMENT WEATHER**

The Committee will make every effort to complete this event in its entirety. However, The Committee reserves the right to suspend or abandon play as necessary if weather-related circumstances require such action. In the unlikely event the course is unplayable and abandons play or other conditions warranting such action. The Committee then will decide the action taken for The Tournament and all competitors will be informed accordingly.

### **24. STANDARD OF PLAYER CONDUCT**

All players should practice good conduct as detailed in Rule 1.2 of the Rules of Golf. The followings but not limited to are samples of misconduct:

- a. Usage of hand phone during the competitions rounds to the destruction of other.
- b. Verbal abuse of fellow competitor/official/staff.
- c. Intentionally distracting or offending other players.
- d. Consuming alcoholic drinks during play.
- e. Dangerous play, with no regard for safety of others.
- f. Any other "code of conduct" not listed above but are deemed to be serious by the Committee.

### **PENALTY FOR BREACH OF CODE OF CONDUCT**

First breach            Verbal warning from referee/committee and told that he/she has a further breach he/she will be penalized.

Second breach        One Stroke penalty

Third breach           Additional Two Penalty Strokes

Fourth Breach        Disqualification

Note: Committee may disqualify player for serious misconduct on first breach.

### **25. OTHERS**

- a. Tee times and pairings will be posted on the announcement board at the Club House and the tournament website.



- b. Markers (scorer) will be assigned to the Class C players. When the situation requires, the Committee will also assign a marker (scorer) to players in other classes. Players must use official caddies assigned by the host club.

## **26. DISQUALIFICATIONS**

In the event that the Committee is required to make any decision involving the penalty of disqualification in relation to Rule 20.2, each country whose player is involved may appoint a nonvoting observer to attend.
